Two college students, Julia Carpey and Nicole Niederman, members of the University of Pittsburgh's Alpha Epsilon Phi Nu Chapter, started an event on October 17, 2011 for Sharsheret, an organization which connects women who are currently suffering from breast cancer with women who have survived breast cancer and in turn raises awareness. The girls planned an event which sells uniquely designed sports bras (created by Julia's graphic designer brother, Benjamin Carpey) that say "I Support My Girls" on the front with a breast cancer ribbon with a different spin on it on the back. The girls who created and are running these sales originally had dreams of selling 200 or so bras in one week's time if they were lucky, but with the social media connections of Facebook and Twitter as well as the power of good-ole'-fashioned word of mouth, the girls have been flooded with over 600 orders in just one week. The event's sales are still open to the public and the girls are now accepting orders online because of the amazing influx of orders internationally. The sports bras are \$20 a piece and 100% of the profit goes to Sharsheret. Q: Does a nurse have a legal duty to protect a patient from incompetent medical care on the part of a doctor or other medical provider?

A: Under Pennsylvania medical malpractice law, if a nurse witnesses incompetent care on the part of a fellow nurse, doctor or other medical provider that leads to injury to the patient, the nurse has a duty to report the negligent conduct, and that nurse can also be a named defendant in the malpractice suit if she/he does not report the negligent care or otherwise seek to correct it.

recipe of the month

MUSHROOM BARLEY CASSEROLE

- 8 oz. barley shaped pasta, plain
or toasted
- 1 env. onion soup mix
- 1 (4-oz.) can sliced mushrooms
- ½ stick butter

Cook and drain barley according to package instructions.

Add butter to hot barley and stir to melt. Stir in onion soup mix and mushrooms.

Pour into a casserole dish and bake at 350° F for 30 minutes. ■

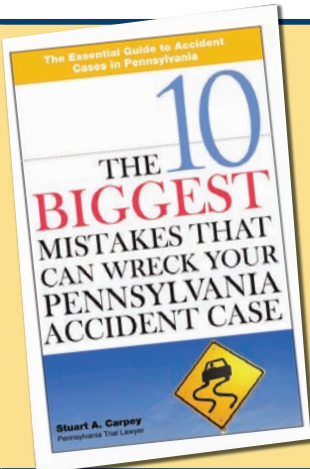

new proposal to ban cell phone use AMONG COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVERS



As a response to a catastrophic trucking accident which took place during March of 2010, the National Transportation Safety Board has recommended banning all cell phone use by commercial truck drivers operating 18-wheel semis. The accident, which took place in Munfordville, Kentucky, claimed the lives of 11 people, including the truck's driver. According to investigators, excessive cell phone use was a major cause of the accident. In the year since the tragedy, fervor has surrounded the use of cell phones by commercial truck drivers. The Department of Transportation is already considering a rule to ban the nation's 3.7 million commercial drivers from talking on cell phones; last year it banned them from texting. The rule proposes fines up to \$2,750 for drivers who interact in any way with a hand-held phone, and \$11,000 for motor carriers who permit their drivers to use phones. ■

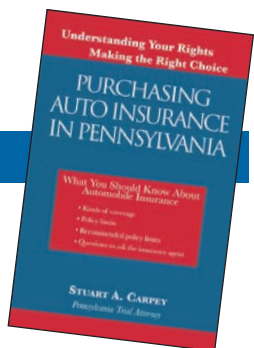
